## Laurentide Ice Sheet source of rhyolite Pope Farm Conservancy **Rhyolite** Rhyolite is a distinctive type of rock you can see in the stone rhyolite fence. This light red rock with orange or light blue spots is a volcanic rock. It comes from an east-west trending band of rock that extends eastward beneath Lake Superior from the Keweenaw Peninsula of Michigan. The flowing ice of the Green Bay Lobe carried these pieces of rhyolite to Pope Farm Conservancy.
